COUNCIL MATTERS

The last Council Meeting was held on Wednesday 23 July 2025.

Annual Budget 2025/26

Council adopted its annual budget for the 2025/26 Financial Year with a 3.5% rates increase. Council have committed \$3.4 million towards its roads maintenance program. Full details and the adopted budget will be posted on the Shire's website in the next couple of weeks while the public document is finalised.

Nyabing Drift and Motorkhana Event

Council endorsed a hire agreement to use the Nyabing Go Kart track for the Nyabing Drift and Motorkhana event run by Great Southern Street Machine Association which will be held Saturday and Sunday 9 and 10 August 2025. It's fantastic to see this event return for its fourth iteration.

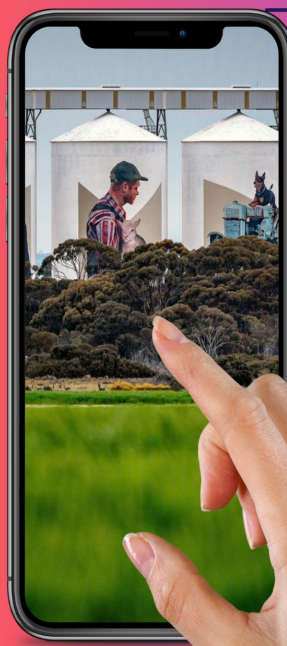

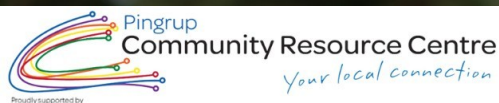

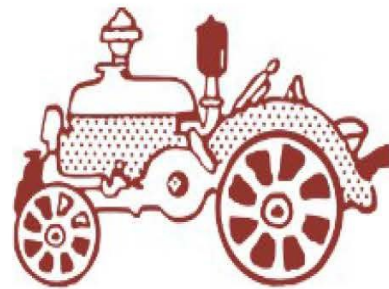
