Pingrup is celebrating 100 years in 2023. The first settlers came to the area in 1911. The town came to life with the railway extension from Katanning, opening in October 1923 and then gazetted in early 1924.

To celebrate the milestone of 100 years the Pingrup Centenary Committee have partnered with the Shire of Kent to build a Centenary Wall with plaques representing families past and present.

The Centennial Committee invites all past and present community members, families and individuals to purchase a plaque with Names and Personal Narratives representing your involvement in the last 100 years of Pingrup.

Plaques will be stainless steel cut & drilled A5 Size 210mm x 148mm.

Multiple plaques are welcome narrating different time periods and families.

EXAMPLE

Tom Brown & Mary Brown *Knee Winters*

1956 - 1999

Mary Brown, Daughter of D and W Winters, Married Tom in 1976 before having two children, Annie and Alex Brown. Children left to pursue careers in nursing and automotives. Tom and Mary left the district in 1999.
