To wind down after all the fun and games, we gathered for a cozy Easter movie session, complete with popcorn — the perfect ending to a magical day.

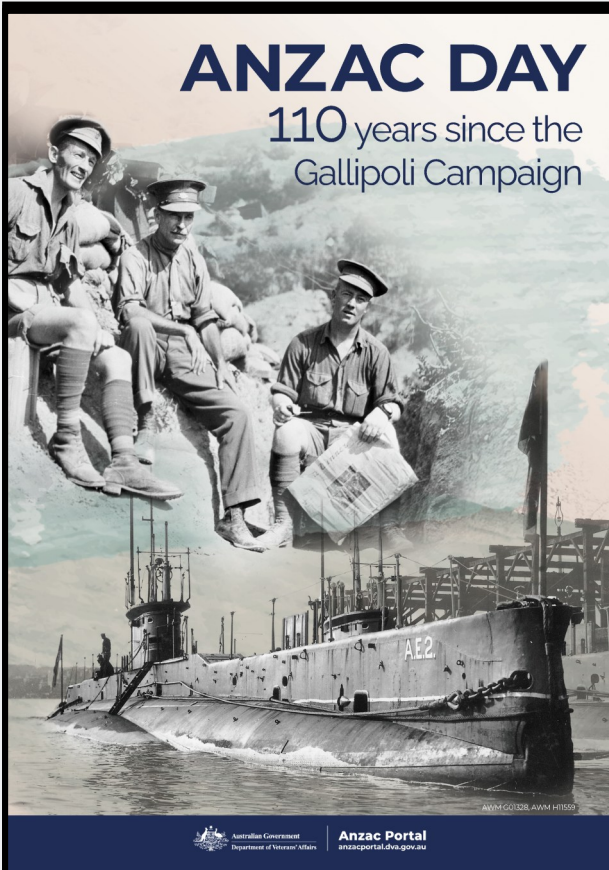
A big thank you to Shania and Lucy who helped make the day so special. We loved seeing the community children come together to celebrate and create memories.

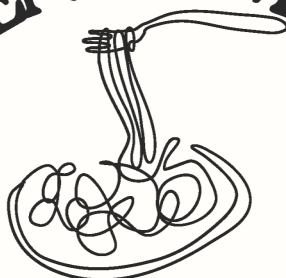
